- 1) Executive Engineer, WBSIDCL invites Bids through electronic quotation (NIEQ) for from the bonafide, resourceful, and reliable experienced agencies. Job detailed in the table below:

Note: In the event of e-filing intending bidder may download the tender document from the website, <https://wbtenders.gov.in> directly by the help of Digital Signature Certificate & necessary Earnest Money & cost of Tender Documents, will be deposited by the bidder electronically: online through his net banking enabled bank account, maintained at any bank or offline through any bank by generating NEFT/RTGS Challan from the e-tendering portal. Intending Bidder will get the Beneficiary details from e-tender portal with the help of Digital Signature Certificate and may transfer the EMD from their respective bank as per the Beneficiary Name and Account No., Amount, Beneficiary Bank Name (ICICI) and IFSC Code and also e-procurement Ref. No.

2) Payment procedure:**A. Payment by Net Banking (any listed bank) through ICICI Bank Payment Gateway:**

- i. On selection of net banking as the payment mode, the bidder will be directed to ICICI Bank Payment Gateway;
- ii. Bidder will make the payment after entering his Unique ID and password of the bank to process the transaction.
- iii. Bidder will receive a confirmation message regarding success/failure of the transaction.
- iv. If the transaction is successful, the amount paid by the bidder will get credited in the respective Pooling account of the State Government/PSU/Autonomous Body/local Body/PRI, etc. maintained with the Focal Point Branch of ICICI Bank at R.N. Mukherjee Road, Kolkata for collection of EMD/Tender Fees.,
- v. If the transaction is failure, the bidder will again try for payment by going back to the first step.

B. Payment through RTGS/NEFT:

- i. On selection of RTGS/NEFT as the payment mode, the e-Procurement portal will show a pre-filled challan having the details to process RTGS/NEFT transaction.
- ii. The bidder will print the challan and use the pre-filled information to make RTGS/NEFT payment using his Bank account.
- iii. Once payment is made, the bidder will come back to the e-Procurement portal after expire of a reasonable time to enable the NEFT/RTGS process to complete, in order to verify the payment made and continue the bidding process.
- iv. If verification is successful, the fund will get credited to the respective Pooling account of the State Government/PSU/Autonomous Body/Local Body etc maintained with the Focal Point Branch of ICICI Bank at R.N. Mukherjee Road, Kolkata for collection of EMD/Tender Fees.
- v. Hereafter, the bidder will go to e-Procurement portal for submission of his bid.

C. Refund/Settlement Process:

- i. After opening of the bids and technical evaluation of the same by the tender inviting authority through electronic processing in the e-Procurement portal of the State Government, the tender inviting authority will declare the status of the bids as successful or unsuccessful which will be made available, along with the details of the unsuccessful bidder, to ICICI Bank by the e-Procurement portal through web services.
- ii. On receipt of the information from the e-Procurement portal, the Bank will refund, through an automated process, the EMD of the bidders disqualified at the technical evaluation to the respective bidders' bank accounts from which they made the payment transaction. Such refund will take place within T+2 Bank Working Days where T will mean the date of which information on rejection of bid is uploaded to the e-Procurement portal by the tender inviting authority.

- iii. Once the financial bid evaluation is electronically processed in the e-Procurement portal, EMD of the technically qualified bidders other than that of the L1 and L2 bidders will be refunded, through an automated process, to the respective bidder's bank accounts from which they made the payment transaction. Such refund will take place within T+2 Bank Working Days where T will mean the date on which information on rejection of financial bid is uploaded to the e-Procurement portal by the tender inviting authority. However, the L2 bidder should not be rejected till the LOI process is successful.
- iv. If the L1 bidder accepts the LOI and the same is processed electronically in the e-Procurement portal, EMD of the L2 bidder will be refunded through an automated process, to his bank account from which he made the payment transaction. Such refund will take place within T+2 Bank Working Days where T will mean the date on which information on Award of Contract (AOC) to the L1 bidders uploaded to the e-Procurement portal by the tender inviting authority.
- v. As soon as the L1 bidder is awarded the contract (AOC) and the same is processed electronically in the e-Procurement portal –
 - a) EMD of the L1 bidder will automatically get transferred from the pooling account to the account of The West Bengal Small Industries Development Corporation Ltd. along with the bank particulars of the L1 bidder.
 - b) EMD of the L1 bidder for tenders of the State PSUs/Autonomous Bodies/Local Bodies etc will automatically get transferred from the pooling account to their respective linked bank accounts along with the bank particulars of the L1 bidder. In both the above cases, such transfer will take place within T+1 Bank Working Days where T will mean the date on which the Award of Contract (AOC) is issued.
- vi. Once the EMD of the L1 bidder is transferred in the manner mentioned above, Tender fees, if any, deposited by the bidders will be transferred electronically from the pooling account to the account of The West Bengal Small Industries Development Corporation Ltd.
- vii. All refunds will be made mandatorily to the Bank A/C from which the payments of EMD were initiated.

3) **Eligibility criteria for participation in tender:**

The intending bidder must fulfil the following eligibility criteria: -

- a) The prospective bidders shall have satisfactorily completed as a prime agency during the last 5(Five) years from the date of issue of this Notice at least one work of similar nature of conducting similar **works for preparation of as built plan using DGPS / Total Station / 3D Laser etc.** for Government Departments (e.g., PWD, KMDA, WBIIDC, WBSIDC, Land & Land Reforms Dept. etc.) or reputed ULBs, PSUs. **Attach Work Orders + Completion Certificates.**
- b) Minimum average annual turnover of **Rs. 30.00 Lakh** in last 3 financial years (2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-25). CA certificate with UDIN required.
- c) The bidder is not blacklisted by any Central/State Government or PSU as of the bid date.

Note: -

- i. Completion certificate should contain a) Name of work (b) Name & address of Client (c) Nature of work executed (d) Date of commencement of work (e) Date of completion of work etc.
- ii. An undertaking should be given stating thereby that the Firm has not been debarred or penalized for any reasons out of work by any Government Department.
- iii. Subletting of contract is strictly prohibited.

4) Security Deposit:

A sum of 10% (Ten percent) of the gross amount of each bill shall be deducted from the bills of the selected consultant as Security Deposit. The total accumulated Security Deposit shall be retained by WBSIDCL and released in the following manner: The total SD will be refunded only after the successful completion of the entire scope of work. In the event of a breach of contract, failure to provide service, or negligence during the contract period, WBSIDCL shall have the right to forfeit the accumulated Security Deposit in part or in full, in addition to other penal measures. No interest shall be payable on the Security Deposit or EMD held by the Corporation.

5) Scope of Services

The scope includes, but is not limited to:

A) Site Survey & Data Collection: -

- i. Physical measurement of the entire building - internal and external.
- ii. Verification of plot boundary, setbacks, building footprint.
- iii. Measurement of all rooms, corridors, lobbies, staircases, lift shafts, balconies, terraces, parapets.
- iv. Measurement of wall thickness, column & beam positions and sizes (where visible).
- v. Measurement of all openings - doors, windows, ventilators with sill and lintel heights.
- vi. Measurement of floor-to-floor heights, slab thickness, ceiling heights, sunshades/chajjas.
- vii. Location of all services as visible - electrical points, plumbing fixtures, sanitary lines, AC units, drains, manholes, water tanks, septic tank.
- viii. Site levels, plinth level, road level.
- ix. Photographic documentation of existing condition.

B) Architectural As-Built Drawing Preparation: -

- i. Preparation of accurate floor plans for all floors including Ground, Typical Floors, Terrace.
- ii. Preparation of roof / terrace plan showing water tanks, parapet, drainage.
- iii. Preparation of minimum 2 nos. sections - Longitudinal and Cross Section through staircase.
- iv. Preparation of all side elevations - Front, Rear, and Side Elevations.
- v. Preparation of detailed Area Statement - Carpet, Built-up, Super Built-up, Floor-wise.

7) Technical Bid:

Technical bid should contain all the documents like Tender documents along with Annexures, General terms & conditions, Instructions to bidders, self-attested copies of all the documents in support of eligibility etc. All documents must be duly filled in, stamped & signed by the bidder. Technical bid should contain 02 (two) covers, Statutory Cover & Non-Statutory Cover.

Statutory Cover should only contain –1) NIT, 2) EMD payment document, and 3) Bidder Information sheet as per Annexure, Declaration. No other documents are to be included in this cover.

Non-Statutory Cover should contain all other mandatory documents as stated below, Legible photocopies of all documents duly attested by the bidder or his authorized representative are to be submitted:

- a) PAN Card, Trade license, GST, EPF & ESIC (if applicable) Registration certificate, and Valid Professional Tax Registration certificate and Current GST Return.
- b) Income Tax Returns/Acknowledgements for three assessment years (AY 2025-26, AY 2024-25, AY 2023-24).
- c) Audited Balance Sheet & Profit & Loss A/c for three financial years (FY 2024-25, FY 2023-24, FY 2022-23).
- d) Firm/Company incorporation documents (Certificate of Incorporation and Memorandum and Articles of Association for companies and Partnership Deed for partnership firms etc.).
- d) Credential Certificate of rendering similar nature service under authority of State/ Central Govt. undertaking/statutory bodies constituted under the statue of the central/State Govt, during the last 5(Five) years from the date of issue of this Notice. **Attach Work Orders + Completion Certificates**
- e) Amount of Average Annual turnover & Working Capital Certificate, duly certified by CA with UDIN, as per the prescribed format attached.

8) Financial Bid:

The bidder shall quote a **lump-sum fee** online only in the "Bill of Quantities (BOQ)" in the space marked for quoting rates in ‘price schedule’ format (Online mode).

The rate shall be inclusive of all professional fees, costs related to surveys, equipment, software licensing, and administrative expenses. The fee must cover all travel, transportation, lodging, boarding, fooding, and out-of-pocket expenses for the consultant's team during site visits and meetings. **The rate shall be inclusive of GST, all applicable central/state taxes, cess, and levies.** No additional claims for taxes will be entertained beyond the quoted price. The Corporation will not provide any accommodation, vehicle, or office space. The agency must make its own arrangements for the entire duration of the contract. **Area / floor variation of tentative area will not attract extra payment. Lump-sum rate is fixed for entire contract period. No escalation, no idle charges payable.**

9) Award of Contract:

The bidder who meets the technical qualifications and quotes the lowest rate will be considered as the L1 (Lowest) bidder. **The L1 bidder will be awarded the work**, subject to fulfilling all other terms and conditions of the tender.

10) Deliverables:

For every work order executed, the agency must submit the 2(two) sets draft / 5 (five) sets of Final following to the Engineer-in-Charge:

11) Payment Terms:

100% payment will be processed only after successful completion of the field survey, submission of all required deliverables (hard copies + soft copies), and final acceptance by the Engineer-in-Charge. No advance payment will be made. Statutory deductions such as TDS, GST TDS, and any other tax/levy as applicable under Govt. rules shall be recovered from the bill. The agency shall be responsible for all tax liabilities.

12) Standard Timeline & Milestones:

Unless specifically altered in a distinct Work Order, the following standard timeline shall apply from the Date of Issue of the Work Order (T):

13) Detailed Terms & Conditions:

- i) The bidder has to furnish all information as required regarding their offer. All correspondence, documents, and bids exchanged between the Bidder and WBSIDCL shall be written in the English language. Failure to comply may disqualify a bidder.
- ii) The WBSIDCL reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders, at its discretion, without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- iii) The quoted rate must be valid for a period of 180 days from the date of opening of the tender. Bids with shorter validity will be treated as unresponsive and summarily rejected.
- iv) If a bidder withdraws or modifies the offer during the validity period, the EMD shall be forfeited. Bidders must be prepared to extend validity if required without changing original terms.
- v) Tenders with incomplete/incorrect information or conditional/subjective offers are liable for rejection.
- vi) WBSIDCL reserves the right to seek clarifications or original hard copies of submitted documents. Failure to produce these within the stipulated time will lead to rejection.
- vii) In case of a tie among lowest bidders, the provisions of Memorandum No. 2320–F(Y) dated 07.06.2022 of Finance Department, Govt. of West Bengal, shall be followed.
- viii) Before issuance of Work Order, credentials will be verified. If any document is found false or fabricated, the Work Order will not be issued and legal measures/blacklisting will be initiated.
- ix) The agency shall enter into a formal agreement with WBSIDCL within the time specified in the Work Order.
- x) The agency is responsible for compliance with all Laws/Acts (Minimum Wages, EPF, ESI, etc.) for any personnel or surveyors deployed at the site.
- xi) WBSIDCL shall not be responsible for any injury, damage, or loss of life incurred by the agency's employees or experts in the course of their duty.
- xii) The selected bidder shall compensate for any loss caused to property due to negligence on the part of personnel deployed by the bidder.
- xiii) No interest will be payable by WBSIDCL on deposited Earnest Money, Security Deposit, or Additional Performance Security.
- xiv) Conditional tenders shall be straightway rejected and no additional clauses will be entertained.
- xv) The Tenderer is advised to visit and acquaint himself with the site conditions at his own cost prior to submission.
- xvi) Bidders must track all Addenda/Corrigenda issued on www.wbtenders.gov.in and upload signed copies. Tenders without relevant Addenda/Corrigenda shall be rejected.
- xvii) The professional fee and rates quoted in the BOQ shall remain fixed for the entire contract, inclusive of all taxes (GST), overheads, transportation, lodging, and fooding.
- xviii) WBSIDCL reserves the right to assess the capability and capacity of the bidder in the overall interest of the Corporation.
- xix) In no event shall WBSIDCL be liable for special, incidental, or consequential damages arising from the services rendered.
- xx) The agency's authorized representatives may be required to visit the WBSIDCL office, other relevant government departments (like Land & Land Reforms), or site offices for necessary coordination, technical discussions, and presentations on the executed survey works, as and when required by WBSIDCL. No additional TA/DA or fees shall be paid for such visits.
- xxi) Each bidder shall submit Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 10,000.00 along with the proposal. If EMD @ 2% of quoted amount exceeds Rs. 10,000.00, as mentioned in the NIEQ, additional amount shall have to be paid in the form of D.D./P.O. etc. drawn in favour of "The West Bengal Small Industries Development Corporation Ltd." Payable at Kolkata on acceptance

and before execution of agreement. The EMD shall be refundable and must be submitted in the form of Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque in favour of "The West Bengal Small Industries Development Corporation Ltd." payable at Kolkata. EMD of successful bidders will be refunded after successful completion of the work. The EMD shall be liable to be forfeited if the bidder withdraws the bid during the validity period, or fails to sign the agreement, or fails to execute the assigned works within the stipulated time.

- xxii) Time is essence of contract. If agency fails to submit within stipulated timeline, penalty of 1% of work order value per day of delay (max 10%) will be deducted. Further WBSIDCL may cancel work order and get work done by other agency at risk & cost of defaulting agency.
- xxiii) Sub-contracting or outsourcing the awarded work to any third party is strictly prohibited and will lead to immediate cancellation of work.
- xxiv) All maps, data, information are absolute property of WBSIDCL. Agency shall maintain confidentiality and not share with third party. Violation will invite legal action and blacklisting.
- xxv) The agency is solely responsible for the accuracy of the survey. Any errors or discrepancies discovered later must be rectified by the agency at their own cost immediately upon notification.
- xxvi) Selected agencies to sign agreement within 7 days on Rs.100 stamp paper.
- xxvii) WBSIDCL reserves the right to terminate the work order of any agency by giving a 7-day notice in case of consistent poor quality of work, repeated delays, misbehavior, or non-compliance with Tender terms.
- xxviii) In case of any dispute, the decision of the Managing Director, WBSIDCL, shall be final and binding. The jurisdiction for all legal matters will be the courts in Kolkata.
- xxix) The agency must be capable of working anywhere in West Bengal.
- xxx) The agency shall take necessary insurance cover for their manpower and equipment during site work. WBSIDCL will not be liable for any accident.
- xxxi) Any objection regarding evaluation of bids, if any, shall be lodged in writing to the Chairman, Tender Screening Committee within 48 (forty-eight) hours from the publication of the list of technically qualified bidders. No objection shall be entertained by the Screening Committee beyond the said time period.
- xxxii) No CONDITIONAL/ INCOMPLETE QUOTATION will be accepted under any circumstances.

14) FORCE MAJEURE:

War, invasion, revolution, riots, sabotage, lockouts, strikes, work shut-downs imposed by Government Acts or Legislation or other authorities, acts of God, epidemics, fires, earthquakes, floods, explosions, accidents, sea navigation blockades or any other acts or events whatsoever which are beyond the control of WBSIDCL and which will directly or indirectly prevent completion of the consultancy services within the time specified in the agreement will be considered FORCE MAJEURE. If the Contract is delayed or impeded in the execution of the work by circumstances of Force Majeure as herein defined, then the Agency/ Owner as the case may be, shall, within one week, give notice in writing to the Owner/Agency, of the existence of circumstances of Force Majeure, together with the evidence relied upon.

In the event that the Parties are unable in good faith to agree that a Force Majeure Event has occurred, the Parties shall submit the dispute in writing to the Head of the Corporation, provided

that the burden of proof as to whether a force Majeure event has occurred shall be upon the Party claiming a Force Majeure Event.

Neither party shall be considered to be in default or in breach of his obligations under the Contract to the extent that performance of such obligations is prevented by any circumstances of Force Majeure which arise after the date of acceptance of Letter of Intent / Effective Date. In the event that Force Majeure circumstances continue for a period of more than one month, both the parties may discuss and mutually agree upon the future course of action which may include termination of Contract.

15) CANCELLATION/TERMINATION OF ORDER:

In the event of your failure to execute any of the Contractual Obligations, WBSIDCL reserves the right to terminate the contract in full / part or terminate for convenience with payment only for milestones successfully completed, as deemed fit by WBSIDCL, at your Risk and Cost by giving 07 (seven) days' Notice to you. In case of termination of the contract, WBSIDCL reserves the right to get the work done by deploying other Agency/Agencies. Cost incurred for the above will be recovered from your Bill & Security Deposit.

16) Forfeiture of Security Deposit and Earnest Money & Additional Performance Security, if any:

On placement of order, if the Agency refuses to take up the job or withdraw his service in midway of the contractual period for any reason whatsoever, then the Earnest money and/or total Security Deposit shall be forfeited as per discretion of the WBSIDCL and other penal action may be taken as deemed fit.

17) Arbitration / Settlement of Disputes:

There is no provision of Arbitration.

If any dispute(s) or difference(s) of any kind whatsoever arise between the parties hereto in connection with or arising out of this contract, the Managing Director, WBSIDCL shall negotiate between the parties hereto with a view to its amicable resolution and settlement within a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date on which the dispute(s) or difference(s) arose.
